

New Phone Systems—Spend Less Time Holding!

We understand that being stuck in a phone queue during peak times, even for something simple, can be frustrating. You will be pleased to hear we have now added a 'callback' facility to our current telephone system.

When you are 5th or higher in the queue, you will be offered a 'callback' option if you do not wish to hold. If you choose the option for a callback by pressing 'zero' on your keypad, the system will confirm that your position in the queue has been saved so you may now hang up. When you become first in the queue, the system will call you back and all you need to do is answer your phone to begin talking to a receptionist. * **Please note that if you miss the callback you will lose your place in the queue and you will need to call us again.** We hope this new system improves patient contact with us.

<u>Covid, Pneumococcal and</u> <u>Shingles Vaccinations</u>

We are currently inviting patients who are eligible for the Spring Covid vaccination—over 75 year olds, patients in care homes and immune-suppressed patients. Invites for the Covid booster will be sent via text, allowing you to selfbook an appointment in a specific clinic.

We will also be contacting patients who are eligible for shingles and pneumococcal vaccinations during the spring/summer months.

We hope to lessen the number of vaccinations patients need to have during the winter months when we also offer influenza and covid vaccinations in addition to shingles and pneumococcal vaccinations.
